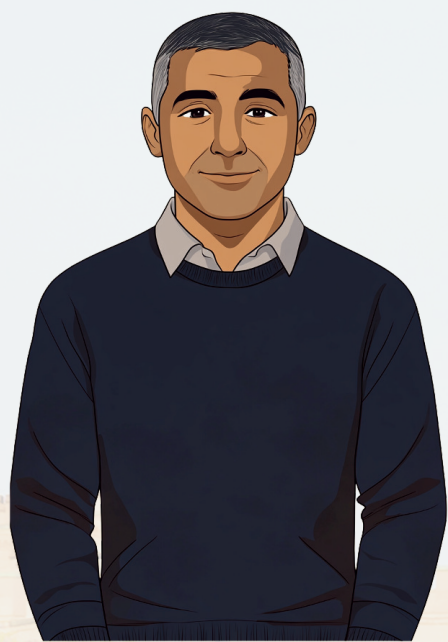


# Newcomer Clinic Evaluation Storytelling - London, Ontario

“We use psychological services for my son. He had a lot of problems in school, because of racism, and bad experiences from the past. He has really benefitted from those therapy meetings.”



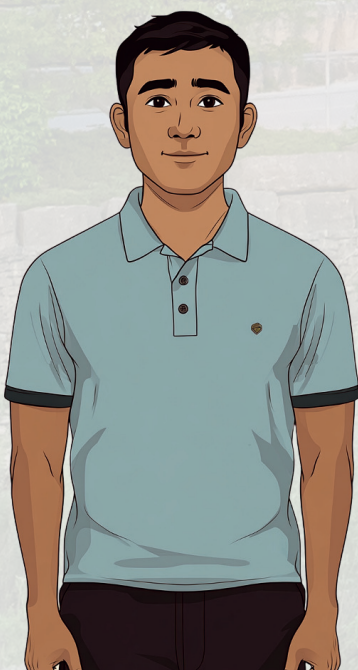
**FARAH - JORDAN**
