**Study Name: A community-based participatory action research project exploring the use of arts-based and embodied learning methods to support frontline service providers in the social services and community health sectors working in settlement and newcomer-serving organizations with their leadership and development as agents of social change**

We are seeking research participants for a study looking at innovative and collaborative arts-based and creative educational methods to support the wellbeing and capacity of frontline service who meet the following criteria:

- ✓ **Currently a frontline worker in the social services and community health sectors.**
- ✓ **Have 5 years' experience working in settlement.**

- ✓ **Participate in a focus group discussion on your experience**

Full participation would involve 4 collaborative group learning sessions (2 hours each) an optional community-based/knowledge mobilization event (4 hours) and both an interview (1.5 hours) and focus group session (2 hours). The total time commitment is approximately 15-20 hours spread over a year.

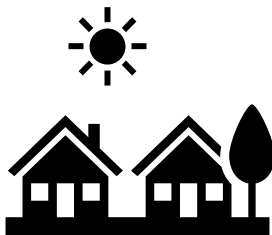
